## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2013-2014:

5           1. To be expended by the department of education:

6           A. Ala Wai elementary school, Oahu

7                 Equipment for the addition of eight security cameras  
8                 to the current security system.

11           B. Ala Wai elementary school, Oahu

12                 Plans, design, and construction for a covered walkway  
13                 between the main office and the cafeteria.

2 Plans, design, and construction for the resurfacing

3 and extending of the basketball courts on the

21 robotics experiments). Renovations and retrofitting  
22 including appropriate work space, countertops,



1 electrical and water supplies, presentation equipment,  
2 and computer hardware and software.
