A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to make permanent
- 2 the exemption for the procurement of food or fuel products
- 3 necessary for the Kaho'olawe island reserve commission to carry
- 4 out the purposes of chapter 6K, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 5 SECTION 2. Act 159, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
- 6 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 7 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010;
- 8 provided that the amendment made to section 103D-102(c), Hawaii
- 9 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed when section
- 10 103D-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted on July 1, 2012,
- 11 by section 14 of Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009[+ provided
- 12 further that this Act shall be repealed on July 1, 2013; and
- 13 provided further that, on July 1, 2013, section 103D 102, Hawaii
- 14 Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which it
- 15 read on the day before the effective date of Act 175, Session
- 16 Laws of Hawaii 2009]."

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2013.
