
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$165,398,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
6 representative district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the judiciary:

8 Kona judiciary complex
9 Design, engineering, and
10 construction of the Kona judiciary
11 complex.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
