RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 103D-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The chief procurement officer for each of the
4	following	state entities shall be:
5	(1)	The judiciarythe administrative director of the
6		courts;
7	(2)	The senatethe president of the senate;
8	(3)	The house of representatives the speaker of the house
9		of representatives;
10	(4)	The office of Hawaiian affairsa person designated by
11		the board of trustees of the office of Hawaiian
12		affairs, who shall not be the chairperson of the
13		board;
14	(5)	The University of Hawaiia person designated by the
15		board of regents of the University of Hawaii, who
16		shall not be the president of the University of
17		Hawaii;

1	(6)	The department of education, excluding the Hawaii
2		public library systema person designated by the
3		board of education, who shall not be the
4		superintendent of education;
5	(7)	The Hawaii health systems corporationa person
6		designated by the Hawaii health systems corporation
7		board, who shall not be the chief executive officer of
8		the Hawaii health systems corporation; and
9	(8)	The remaining departments of the executive branch of
10		the State and all governmental bodies administratively
11		attached to themthe administrator of the state
12		procurement office of the department of accounting and
13		general services.
14	(b)	The chief procurement officers for each of the several
15	counties	shall be:
16	(1)	The executive branchthe respective finance directors
17		of the several counties, except as provided in
18		paragraphs (3), (4), and (5);
19	(2)	The legislative branchthe respective chairpersons of
20		the councils of the several counties;
21	(3)	The Honolulu, Kauai, and Maui boards or departments of
22		water supplypersons designated by the boards or

1		departments, who shall not be the managers and chief
2		engineers of the respective boards or departments of
3		water supply as designated by county charter;
4	(4)	The Hawaii board of water supplya person designated
5		by the Hawaii board of water supply, who shall not be
6		the manager of the board of water supply as designated
7		by county charter; and
8	(5)	The semi-autonomous public transit agencya person
9		designated by the board of directors of the semi-
10		autonomous public transit agency, who shall not be the
11		executive director or chief executive officer of the
12		agency as designated by county charter;
13	provided that the chief procurement officers designated under	
14	paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5) shall not exercise their	
15	powers or duties over contracting in a manner contrary to the	
16	respective county's charter, ordinances, or rules adopted in	
17	accordance with chapter 91."	
18	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
20	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
