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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$59,285,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014,  
5 and \$12,000,000 for fiscal year 2014-2015, as indicated, for the  
6 purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-first  
7 representative district, as follows:

8 I. To be expended by the department of education:

9       1. Aiea Elementary School, Oahu

10           A. Design and construction of a STEM Center on campus to  
11 include a lab, engineering design and construction  
12 area, training/presentation area, office space, and  
13 possible greenhouse area; building would be LEED

10 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective  
11 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
12 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of  
13 this Act.

14 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital  
15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
17 provided that:

18 (1) From the appropriations made for fiscal year 2013-  
19 2014, all moneys unencumbered as of June 30, 2016,  
20 shall lapse as of that date; and



1 (2) From the appropriations made for fiscal year 2014-  
2 2015, all moneys unencumbered as of June 30, 2017,  
3 shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
