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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF  
THE FIFTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall

3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2013-2014.
