
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 5-7.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[+]§5-7.7[+]~~ **Aloha order of merit location.** There shall
4 be set aside within the [~~Honolulu International Airport~~] Daniel
5 K. Inouye International Airport an area to exhibit commemorative
6 displays honoring members of the order. The displays may
7 include likenesses of members and descriptions of the
8 meritorious achievements of each member."

9 SECTION 2. Section 102-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

11 "(b) All security provided under this section shall:

12 (1) Be conditioned on the full and faithful performance of
13 the contract in accordance with the terms and intent
14 thereof;

15 (2) Be in an amount not less than two months' rental and
16 other charges, if any, required under the contract;
17 provided that any contract for the sale and delivery
18 of in bond merchandise at [~~Honolulu International~~



1 ~~Airport]~~ Daniel K. Inouye International Airport shall
 2 require a bond in an amount not less than four months
 3 of the highest minimum annual rental guaranty required
 4 under the contract; and

5 (3) By its terms inure to the benefit of the State or of
 6 the county, as the case may be."

7 SECTION 3. Section 261-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 8 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

9 "(c) The department shall enter into a contract with no
 10 more than one person ("contractor") for the sale and delivery of
 11 in-bond merchandise at [~~Honolulu International Airport,~~] Daniel
 12 K. Inouye International Airport, in the manner provided by law.
 13 The contract shall confer the right to operate and maintain
 14 commercial facilities within the airport for the sale of in-bond
 15 merchandise and the right to deliver to the airport in-bond
 16 merchandise for sale to departing foreign-bound passengers.

17 The department shall grant the contract pursuant to the
 18 laws of this State and may take into consideration:

19 (1) The payment to be made on in-bond merchandise sold at
 20 [~~Honolulu International Airport]~~ Daniel K. Inouye
 21 International Airport and on in-bond merchandise



1 displayed or sold elsewhere in the State and delivered
2 to the airport;

3 (2) The ability of the applicant to comply with all
4 federal and state rules and regulations concerning the
5 sale and delivery of in-bond merchandise; and

6 (3) The reputation, experience, and financial capability
7 of the applicant.

8 The department shall actively supervise the operation of
9 the contractor to ensure its effectiveness. The department
10 shall develop and implement such guidelines as it may find
11 necessary and proper to actively supervise the operations of the
12 contractor, and shall include guidelines relating to the
13 department's review of the reasonableness of contractor's price
14 schedules, quality of merchandise, merchandise assortment,
15 operations, and service to customers.

16 Apart from the contract described in this subsection, the
17 department shall confer no right upon nor suffer nor allow any
18 person to offer to sell, sell, or deliver in-bond merchandise at
19 ~~[Honolulu International Airport,]~~ Daniel K. Inouye International
20 Airport; provided that this section shall not prohibit the
21 delivery of in-bond merchandise as cargo to the ~~[Honolulu~~
22 ~~International Airport.]~~ Daniel K. Inouye International Airport."



1 SECTION 4. Section 261-15.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " ~~[†]~~**§261-15.5**~~[†]~~ **Aircraft registration.** Unless an
4 aircraft is exempted by this section, no person shall operate or
5 cause or authorize to be operated any aircraft at an airport
6 owned or controlled by the department, unless the aircraft has a
7 certificate of registration issued in accordance with rules
8 adopted by the department. Aircraft exempt from registration
9 required by this section include:

- 10 (1) Aircraft operating primarily in interstate or foreign
11 commerce;
- 12 (2) Aircraft owned or operated by the United States;
- 13 (3) Aircraft in transit through the State; and
- 14 (4) Aircraft operated by any scheduled airline carrier
15 which is a lessee of the State under an airport-
16 airline lease at the [~~Honolulu International Airport~~]
17 Daniel K. Inouye International Airport and which is
18 commonly referred to as signatory airline."

19 SECTION 5. Section 261-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 "**§261-23** [~~Honolulu International Airport.~~] Daniel K.
22 Inouye International Airport. All that area set aside by


