## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a center providing 2 comprehensive services for deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals in Hawaii has been the dream of the deaf community 3 4 in Hawaii since 1972. The creation of a comprehensive service center is intended to promote individual growth, social 5 6 awareness, productivity, and equality by empowering deaf, hard 7 of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals to be full participants 8 in Hawaii's overall community. 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 10 department of human services to fund the establishment and 11 operational costs of a comprehensive service center for deaf, 12 hard of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals. 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$400,000 or so much

thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the

establishment and operation of a comprehensive service center

for the deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind.
