## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a center providing 2 comprehensive services for deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind 3 individuals in Hawaii has been the dream of the deaf community 4 in Hawaii since 1972. The creation of a comprehensive service center is intended to promote individual growth, social 5 6 awareness, productivity, and equality by empowering deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals to be full participants 8 in Hawaii's overall community. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 9 10 department of human services to fund the establishment and 11 operational costs of a comprehensive service center for deaf, 12 hard of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals. 13 SECTION 2.

There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the establishment and operation of a comprehensive service center for the deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind. 2013-1915 HB1430 SD1 SMA.doc

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
