A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a center providing

 comprehensive services for deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind

 individuals in Hawaii has been the dream of the deaf community
- 4 in Hawaii since 1972. The creation of a comprehensive service
- 5 center is intended to promote individual growth, social
- $\mathbf{6}$ awareness, productivity, and equality by empowering deaf, hard
- 7 of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals to be full participants
- 8 in Hawaii's overall community.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 10 department of human services to fund the establishment and
- 11 operational costs of a comprehensive service center for deaf,
- 12 hard of hearing, and deaf-blind individuals.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
- 16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 17 2014-2015 for the establishment and operation of a comprehensive
- 18 service center for the deaf, hard of hearing, and deaf-blind.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
