
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-VIOLENCE AND PEACE AWARENESS MONTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§8- Non-violence and Peace Awareness Month. The
5 month of October shall be known and designated as "Non-violence
6 and Peace Awareness Month", to promote public awareness of
7 violence as a significant societal, public health, and criminal
8 justice problem. This month is not and shall not be construed
9 as a state holiday."

10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
