
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$127,890,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6 the ninth representative district, as follows:

 18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

21 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 22 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be




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1 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
