
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that growth and
2 diversification of the State's economy is essential for the
3 prosperity of the State and its residents. One part of the
4 economy that will help drive expansion and diversification is
5 the high technology industry. The expansion and proliferation
6 of this sector helps the State adapt to the ever-changing
7 economic and technological landscape and prepare for the future.
8 The high technology industry also provides attractive and high-
9 paying jobs for talented Hawaii residents and those educated in
10 Hawaii schools, while also helping to reverse the "brain drain"
11 experienced in this State.

12 The department of business, economic development, and
13 tourism's high technology development corporation is at the
14 forefront of the State's efforts to advance high technology with
15 its purpose to promote the growth, development, and prosperity
16 of the high technology industry in the State. Also helping
17 advance high technology is the Manoa innovation center, a
18 program administered by the corporation that serves as an



1 incubator for start-up technology companies. The legislature
2 finds that the success of the corporation and the center is
3 essential for high technology to flourish in the State.

4 Furthermore, the legislature finds that some of the
5 7,000,000-plus annual visitors to the State are interested in
6 working here on a part-time or permanent basis. These
7 prospective residents, however, may require or desire additional
8 knowledge and assistance. Ideally, the high technology
9 development corporation would be able to provide this assistance
10 and further encourage out-of-state high technology industry
11 workers to perform their jobs in Hawaii.

12 The purpose of this Act is to invest in technology
13 development in Hawaii by:

- 14 (1) Facilitating a connection between the high technology
15 industry and visitors to the State and coordinating
16 such activities under any umbrella coordinating effort
17 such as the hi growth initiative; and
- 18 (2) Appropriating funds to the high technology development
19 corporation to develop a program to attract out-of-
20 state software programmers and other high technology
21 workers to work in Hawaii.



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for the
4 high technology development corporation to develop a program
5 where Hawaii's innovation community will benefit from the
6 returning kama'aina and other out-of-state software workers
7 connecting with the state's high technology industry.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the high
9 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
