
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,680,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the benefit
6 of the seventeenth representative district, as follows:

7 I. To be expended by the department of education:

8 1. Henry J. Kaiser high school, Oahu

9 A. Plans, design, and construction of a new track
10 and synthetic turf to replace football field
11 grass.

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 14 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 15 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. The appropriations made for the capital
 17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

21 SECTION 5. Session law material to be repealed is
 22 bracketed and stricken.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
