
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$319,967,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal biennium 2013-
5 2015 capital improvement projects for the seventh representative
6 district, in the respective fiscal years as follows:

22 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at



1 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
2 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
3 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
6 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
7 this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
