## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONDOMINIUMS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that mediation is an
 informal, inexpensive, and confidential process for resolving
 disputes quickly. Mediation may be particularly advantageous in
 a condominium setting because of the potential to preserve or to
 restore harmony within a condominium community.

6 The legislature further finds that fees paid into the 7 condominium education trust fund come entirely from condominium 8 owners. Dedicating a portion of the fund to support the 9 mediation of condominium related disputes will benefit 10 condominium owners and associations.

11 The purpose of this Act is to specify that a percentage of 12 fees paid into the condominium education trust fund shall be 13 used to support mediation of condominium related disputes.

14 SECTION 2. Section 514B-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended to read as follows:

16 "[{]\$514B-71[}] Condominium education trust fund. (a)
17 The commission shall establish a condominium education trust

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1	fund that the commission may use for educational purposes $[-]$ and
2	shall use to support mediation of condominium related disputes.
3	(1) Educational purposes shall include financing or
4	promoting:
5	$\left[\frac{(1)}{(A)}\right]$ Education and research in the field of
6	condominium management, condominium project
7	registration, and real estate, for the benefit of
8	the public and those required to be registered
9	under this chapter;
10	[ <del>(2)</del> ](B) The improvement and more efficient administration
11	of associations; and
12	[ <del>(3)</del> ] (C) Expeditious and inexpensive procedures for
13	resolving association disputes.
14	(2) Support for mediation of condominium related disputes
15	shall include dedicating an amount equal to the sum of
16	\$1 times the number of registered condominium units in
17	Hawaii per year to the payment of community-based and
18	professional mediation services for the benefit of
19	consumers and associations.
20	(b) The commission [may] shall use any and all moneys in
21	the condominium education trust fund for purposes consistent
22	with subsection (a)."
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1 SECTION 3. Section 514B-72, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Each project or association with more than five 4 units, including any project or association with more than five units subject to chapter 514A, shall pay to the department of 5 6 commerce and consumer affairs a condominium education trust fund 7 fee within one year after the recordation of the purchase of the 8 first unit or within thirty days of the association's first 9 meeting, and thereafter, on or before June 30 of every odd-10 numbered year, as prescribed by rules adopted pursuant to 11 chapter 91. The fee shall include a sufficient amount to 12 support the mediation of condominium related disputes, pursuant 13 to section 514B-71(a)." 14 Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed SECTION 4. 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 17
