
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 as a grant-in-aid to the counties of Hawaii and Maui to carry
3 out the intent and purpose of section 205-47, Hawaii Revised
4 Statutes, of identifying and mapping important agricultural
5 lands in each county.

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
9 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2014-2015 as a grant-in aid to facilitate the process of
11 identifying and mapping potential important agriculture lands as
12 required by the counties in section 205-47, Hawaii Revised
13 Statutes.

14 The appropriation shall be as follows:

16 (2) County of Maui \$

17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the respective
18 counties for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.


