### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MAMMOGRAPHY REPORTING.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Breast density mammography results; report and
5	notification. (a) Beginning January 1, 2014, every health care
6	facility in which a mammography examination is performed shall
7	provide a mammography report and notification to each patient
8	who is categorized by the facility as having dense breast
9	tissue. The notification shall include in the summary of the
10	mammography report sent to the patient, the following
11	information, pursuant to the federal Mammography Quality
12	Standards Act:
13	"Your mammogram shows that your breast tissue is
14	dense. Dense breast tissue is very common and is not
15	abnormal. However, dense breast tissue can make it
16	harder to find cancer on a mammogram and may also be
17	associated with an increased risk of breast cancer.
18	This information about the result of your mammogram is

1	given to you to raise your awareness. Use this
2	information to talk to your physician as to whether,
3	based on your risk, more screening tests might be
4	useful. A report of your results was sent to your
5	physician."
6	(b) For purposes of this section, "dense breast tissue"
7	means heterogeneously dense or extremely dense tissue as defined
8	in nationally-recognized guidelines or systems for breast
9	imaging reporting of mammography screening, including the Breast
10	Imaging Reporting and Data System of the American College of
11	Radiology, and any equivalent new terms, as such guidelines or
12	systems are revised."
13	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
