A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EVIDENCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 210, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2008, (Act 210), established a limited news media
- 3 privilege against the compelled disclosure of sources and
- 4 unpublished information to a legislative, executive, or judicial
- 5 officer or body, or to any other person who may compel
- 6 testimony. Act 210 was scheduled to be repealed on June 30,
- 7 2011, and was extended by Act 113, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011,
- 8 until June 30, 2013.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to make permanent the news media
- 10 privilege.
- 11 SECTION 2. Act 210, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, as
- 12 amended by Act 113, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended by
- 13 amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 14 "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
- 15 [and shall be repealed on June 30, 2013]."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2013.
