
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT TRANSPARENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that transparency is
2 important in a democracy.

3 SECTION 2. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
4 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
5 and to read as follows:


6 "§92- Government transparency. All items to be voted on
7 in public meetings shall be posted electronically to a
8 government website at least seventy-two hours prior to the vote.
9 Confidential information may be redacted."

10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
