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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                            or so  
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and  
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal  
5 year 2014-2015 for the state rent supplement program for  
6 homeless individuals or families who work, either part-time or  
7 full-time, and who are ready to rent permanent housing to obtain  
8 and maintain permanent housing and for the department of human  
9 services to hire and train one program specialist to monitor the  
10 state rent supplement program and to enter into contracts to  
11 implement the program on a statewide basis; provided that the  
12 rent supplement shall be available via participation in  
13 workforce development programs or other programs that provide  
14 support to workers to increase self-sufficiency; provided  
15 further that the maximum rent supplement shall be \$300 per month  
16 after households pay a minimum of forty per cent of their  
17 adjusted income for rent.



1           The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
2 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

3           SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
