A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. By no later than July 1, 2014, the Hawaii
2	medical board shall adopt, amend, or repeal rules, pursuant to
3	chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to require physician
4	clinical practitioners to complete twelve hours of continuing
5	medical education on palliative care every four years in order
6	to maintain licensure. The continuing medical education
7	requirement shall take effect on January 1, 2015, and shall not
8	apply to non-clinical physicians.
9	For the purposes of this Act, "non-clinical physicians"
10	includes but is not limited to:
11	(1) Medical examiners;
12	(2) Nuclear medicine doctors;
13	(3) Pathologists;
14	(4) Podiatrists;
15	(5) Public health physicians;
16	(6) Sports medicine physicians; and
17	(7) Physicians performing strictly administrative
18	functions.



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
