

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to promote campaign
- 2 finance reform.
- 3 More specifically, this Act limits the percentage of
- 4 campaign contributions that a noncandidate committee may receive
- 5 from nonresident persons. The legislature finds that this Act
- 6 is necessary to minimize the influence of out-of-state special
- 7 interests on state and local elections.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 11-362, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 10 "(a) Contributions from all persons who are not residents
- 11 of the State at the time the contributions are made shall not
- 12 exceed thirty per cent of the total contributions received by a
- 13 candidate [or], candidate committee, or noncandidate committee
- 14 for each election period."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013. 1

Report Title:

Campaign Contributions; Noncandidate Committees, Limit from Nonresident Persons

Description:

Makes applicable to noncandidate committees the present limit on campaign contributions to a candidate or candidate committee from nonresident persons.

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
