A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD SUPPORT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State can
increase the effectiveness of the child support program by
clarifying the liability of grandparents in accordance with the
Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act
of 1996, Public Law 104-193, 110 Stat. 2105, also known as the
Welfare Reform Act.

7 Currently, thirteen states have enacted legislation that provides grandparent liability for child support: Arizona, 8 9 Idaho, Illinois, Maryland, Missouri, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Ohio, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, 10 11 Wisconsin, and Wyoming. Some of the statutes were enacted in 12 the wake of 42 United States Code section 666(a)(18) and limit 13 the liability of grandparents to those cases where the parents 14 of the child are minors and the custodial parent is receiving 15 public assistance. Other states have legislation that predates the Welfare Reform Act and is modeled on the Elizabethan Poor 16 17 Laws.
