
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the national and
2 global economic crisis that began in the second half of 2008 has
3 caused significant economic problems in numerous industries in
4 the State, including the airline, cruise ship, tourist, and
5 construction industries. Mass layoffs have been reported by an
6 increasing number of Hawaii businesses statewide, from the
7 agricultural sector to the medical-services sector. Difficult
8 economic times and declining tax revenues have resulted in
9 budget cuts for all state services.

10 The current and impending situation jeopardizes the safety
11 net of basic human services, health, and education needs for
12 Hawaii's residents and families. While all of Hawaii's
13 residents will be affected by the situation, gap group families
14 and families closest to the poverty line will suffer the most.

15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys from the
16 general fund to maintain the levels of programs determined to be
17 essential to education, public health, and public welfare.



1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 5 year 2014-2015 for respite services.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 7 of health for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 12 year 2014-2015 to supplement the healthy start program.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 14 of health for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 18 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 19 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 20 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to:

- 21 (1) Catholic Charities Hawaii for the Lanakila Multi-
- 22 Purpose Senior Center \$;



- 1 (2) Moiliili Community Center for the Moiliili Senior
- 2 Center Program \$; and
- 3 (3) Waikiki Community Center \$.

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
5 of health for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
9 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2014-2015 for the kupuna care program.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12 of health for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2014-2015 for the aging and disability resource center.

18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
19 of health for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
22 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and

1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2014-2015 for the developmental disabilities medicaid
3 waiver program.

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
5 of health for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
9 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2014-2015 for mental health services.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12 of health for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2014-2015 for the partnerships in community living program.

18 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
19 of health for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
22 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and



1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2014-2015 for substance abuse treatment.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4 of health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2014-2015 for the healthy aging partnership program.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of health for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
15 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
16 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
17 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Waianae District
18 Comprehensive Health and Hospital Board, Inc., to support its
19 emergency room services.

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the general
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for HIV/AIDS related services and
 7 to be distributed as follows:

- 8 (1) Life Foundation \$;
- 9 (2) Gregory House Programs \$; and
- 10 (3) Community Health Outreach Work to
- 11 Prevent AIDS \$.

12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 13 of health for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 14. There is appropriated out of the general
 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 17 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 18 year 2014-2015 to fund the housing first pilot program for
 19 chronically homeless individuals, including those who have an
 20 addiction or mental illness, or both.

21 The department of human services shall submit a report to
 22 the legislature on the progress of the housing first pilot



1 program no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
2 regular session of 2014.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 15. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2014-2015 for meals for the elderly for kupuna care.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of health's executive office on aging for the purposes of this
12 Act.

13 SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
18 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Kokua Kalihi Valley
19 (Comprehensive Family Services).

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 17. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2014-2015 to be administered by the department of health
6 for services to pregnant women struggling with addiction.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
8 of health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
12 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2014-2015 for the baby S.A.F.E. (substance abuse free
14 environment) program.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
16 of health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the general
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
20 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
21 2014-2015 for fetal alcohol spectrum disorders.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 20. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2014-2015 for family planning services.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2014-2015 for perinatal health programs.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
16 of health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 22. There is appropriated out of the general
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
20 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
21 year 2014-2015 for the preschool developmental screening
22 program.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 23. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
8 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Blueprint for Change for
9 neighborhood place walk-in centers.

10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
11 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 24. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
15 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
16 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
17 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
18 Association for the Hawaii immigrant health initiative program
19 provided at federally qualified health centers.

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 25. There is appropriated out of the general
 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to support domestic violence
 7 shelters statewide and to be distributed as follows:

- 8 (1) Child and Family Service;
- 9 (A) Two shelters on Oahu \$; and
- 10 (B) Two shelters on the Big Island \$;
- 11 (2) Parents and Children Together \$;
- 12 (3) Women Helping Women \$;
- 13 (4) Molokai Community Service
- 14 Council, Inc. \$;
- 15 (5) Young Women's Christian Association
- 16 (YWCA) of Kauai \$;
- 17 (6) Windward Spouse Abuse Shelter \$; and
- 18 (7) Statewide domestic violence shelters \$.

19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 20 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 26. There is appropriated out of the general
 22 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so



1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
2 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
3 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
4 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Hale Mahaolu for personal care
5 services.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
7 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 27. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2014-2015 for the shelter plus care program.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
14 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 28. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
18 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
19 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
20 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
21 Association for adult dental care provided at federally
22 qualified health centers; provided that the funds shall not be



1 used for any other purpose. The governor is authorized to
2 utilize enhanced federal medical assistance percentages funds to
3 offset the amount appropriated; provided that the total amount
4 shall not exceed \$. The department of human services
5 shall report to the legislature on:

- 6 (1) The number of adults receiving these benefits;
- 7 (2) The cost per person;
- 8 (3) Total breakdown of administrative costs and other
9 overhead costs; and
- 10 (4) Statistics, if available, on how this dental program
11 is reducing the number of emergency dental-related
12 medical procedures;

13 provided that the department of human services shall submit its
14 report no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
15 2014 regular session.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 29. There is appropriated out of the general
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
21 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2014-2015 for the adult dental care program at Maui
2 community college, University of Hawaii.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 30. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2014-2015 for outstationed eligibility worker services
10 provided at federally qualified health centers.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 31. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
18 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
19 Association for outreach services provided at federally
20 qualified health centers.

21 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
22 of human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
7 Association for outreach services to locate uninsured children
8 for services at federally qualified health centers.

9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
10 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 2014-2015 for child care subsidies.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
17 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the general
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
21 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
22 year 2014-2015 for the general assistance program under section



1 346-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to maintain the general
2 assistance benefit amount at \$. per person per month or
3 as close to \$ per person per month as possible, given
4 the monthly caseload.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
6 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
11 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
12 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Adult Friends for Youth for
13 youth gang prevention and intervention services.

14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
15 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
19 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
21 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Hawaii Centers for Independent
22 Living for statewide independent living services.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 37. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
7 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
8 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Susannah Wesley Community
9 Center for the Susannah Wesley Community Center Youth Service
10 Center.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
18 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Planned Parenthood of Hawaii
19 for statewide sexual health education.

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Partners in Development
7 Foundation to:

- 8 (1) Provide comprehensive family training (early
9 childhood, parent, adult education, and intensive
10 child-caregiver activities) and transitional services
11 to sheltered and unsheltered homeless families on the
12 leeward coast of Oahu;
- 13 (2) Offer early screening, assessment, and referral
14 services for homeless children from birth to age five;
15 and
- 16 (3) Prepare homeless children for kindergarten by
17 providing developmentally appropriate social,
18 emotional, and cognitive activities in a child-
19 caregiver interactive learning environment.

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 40. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to PATCH (People Attentive to
7 Children) for the preschool open doors program.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 41. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2014-2015 for domestic violence services.

15 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
16 for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 42. There is appropriated out of the general
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
19 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
20 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
21 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter



1 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Volunteer Legal Services Hawai'i
2 to provide pro bono legal services for indigent persons.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
4 for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 43. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
10 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Legal Aid Society of Hawai'i
11 to provide general civil legal services.

12 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
13 for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 44. There is appropriated out of the general
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
17 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
18 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
19 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the Hawaii Family Law Clinic
20 to provide services to obtain temporary restraining orders.

21 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
22 for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 45. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
6 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Catholic Charities Hawaii
7 to provide intra-familial sex assault services.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
9 for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 46. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
15 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to The Children's Alliance of
16 Hawaii, Inc., to provide child sex assault services.

17 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
18 for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 47. There is appropriated out of the general
20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
22 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
2 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Young Men's Christian
3 Association of Honolulu for the operation of the weed and seed
4 program in Kalihi-Palama, Waipahu, and Ewa Beach.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
6 for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 48. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
10 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
11 year 2014-2015 for the office of community services for
12 employment core services.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
14 of labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 49. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
18 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
19 year 2014-2015 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
20 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Disability Rights
21 Center to provide advocacy service to individuals with
22 developmental disabilities and mental illness.



1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 50. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
