## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANDOWNERS' LIABILITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 662, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§662- Limited liability for mountain climbing, rock
- 5 climbing, rappelling, and bouldering. No public entity or
- 6 public employee shall be liable to any person for injury or
- 7 damage sustained on government land when engaged in mountain
- 8 climbing, rock climbing, rappelling, and bouldering."
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 520-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by amending the definition of "land" to read as follows:
- ""Land" means land, roads, water, watercourses, private
- 12 ways and buildings, structures, and machinery or equipment when
- 13 attached to realty[, other than lands owned by the government]."
- 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Description:

Applies limits on liability under chapter 520, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to government-owned land. Exempts public agencies and employees from liability for injury or damage sustained on government land in the course of mountain climbing, rock climbing, rappelling, or bouldering. (HB625 HD1)
