Pharmacies; Remote Dispensing Pharmacies

Description:

Prohibits new remote dispensing pharmacies from operating within ten miles of any pharmacy, excepting those remote dispensing pharmacies in operation prior to the effective date of this measure. Extends the repeal date of Act 212, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, to January 1, 2016. (SD2)
