A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that according to a 2009
2	study, frequent visits to stores selling tobacco and a greater
3	awareness of cigarettes sold in stores increased the likelihood
4	of teenagers being susceptible to initiating smoking,
5	experimenting with smoking, or becoming smokers.
6	The legislature has a compelling interest in reducing the
7	number of children and teens in Hawaii who smoke.

- 8 The purpose of this Act is to reduce the number of minors 9 and youth who smoke by prohibiting the sale of tobacco products 10 and vapor products to minors and the purchase of these items by
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 13
- 14 "§709-908 Tobacco[+] products and vapor products
- 15 prohibited; minors. (1) It shall be unlawful to sell or
- 16 furnish tobacco [in any shape or form, including chewing tobacco
- 17 and snuff, products or vapor products to a minor under eighteen
- years of age. 18

(2) Signs using the statement, "The sale of tobacco 1 products or vapor products to persons under eighteen is 2 3 prohibited", shall be posted on or near any vending machine in letters at least one-half inch high and at or near the point of 4 sale of any other location where tobacco products or vapor 5 products are sold in letters at least one-half inch high. 6 7 (3) It shall be unlawful for a minor under eighteen years of age to purchase any tobacco product $[-\tau]$ or vapor products, as 8 described under subsection $[\frac{1}{2}]$ (5). This provision does not 9 apply if a person under the age of eighteen, with parental 10 11 authorization, is participating in a controlled purchase as part of a law enforcement activity or a study authorized by the 12 department of health under the supervision of law enforcement to 13 determine the level of incidence of tobacco product or vapor 14 15 product sales to minors. (4) Any person who violates subsection (1) or (2), or 16 17 both, shall be fined \$500 for the first offense. Any subsequent 18 offenses shall subject the person to a fine not less than \$500 nor more than \$2,000. Any minor under eighteen years of age who 19 violates subsection (3) shall be fined \$10 for the first 20 21 offense. Any subsequent offense shall subject the violator to a fine of \$50, no part of which shall be suspended, or the person 22

- 1 shall be required to perform not less than forty-eight hours nor
- 2 more than seventy-two hours of community service during hours
- 3 when the person is not employed and is not attending school.
- 4 (5) For the purposes of this section:
- 5 "Tobacco product" means any product made or derived from
- 6 tobacco that is intended for human consumption, including
- 7 cigarettes, cigars, snuff, chewing or smokeless tobacco, and
- 8 smoking or pipe tobacco. Tobacco product shall not include any
- 9 product that is regulated by the United States Food and Drug
- 10 Administration under Chapter V of the Federal Food, Drug, and
- 11 Cosmetic Act.
- "Vapor product" means any noncombustible tobacco derived
- 13 product containing nicotine that employs a mechanical heating
- 14 element, battery, or circuit, regardless of shape or size, that
- 15 can be used to heat a liquid nicotine solution contained in
- 16 cartridges, and includes an electronic cigarette, electronic
- 17 cigar, electronic cigarillo, or electronic pipe. Vapor products
- 18 shall not include any product that is regulated by the United
- 19 States Food and Drug Administration under Chapter V of the
- 20 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act."
- 21 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
