8	community	environmental rehabilitation special fund:
9	(1)	Ten per cent of all moneys received by the State as
10		payment for fines or penalties for environmental
11		violations assessed by the State;
12	(2)	Any appropriation by the legislature into the
13		community environmental rehabilitation special fund;
14	<u>(3)</u>	Any gift, grant, or donation made to the community
15		environmental rehabilitation special fund; and
16	(4)	Any interest earned on sums deposited into the
17		community environmental rehabilitation special fund.

- 1 (c) The department shall expend moneys contained in the
- 2 community environmental rehabilitation special fund to restore,
- 3 improve, or rehabilitate communities affected by the
- 4 environmental violations from which the moneys in subsection
- 5 (b)(1) were generated."

- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
