A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FISHPONDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the repair of many
Hawaiian fishponds may require permits from the department of
land and natural resources, department of health, office of
planning, and federal and county governments.

5 The legislature further finds that the process of obtaining 6 a permit for the restoration of Hawaiian fishponds is time 7 consuming, complicated, confusing, and varies depending upon the 8 circumstances of the party applying for the permit. The 9 existing regulations and permit requirements preclude community 10 organizations and native Hawaiian aquaculturalists from 11 repairing and maintaining Hawaiian fishponds.

12 The State has the ability to streamline the permit process 13 and promote interagency cooperation to facilitate restoration 14 and leasing of fishponds to cultural and familial descendants. 15 However, the State has not led a comprehensive initiative to 16 streamline the permit process for restoration of Hawaiian 17 fishponds in more than thirty years.



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1	The restoration and reuse of loko i'a provide an opportunity

5	The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
6	land and natural resources, department of health, and office of
7	planning, in collaboration with community organizations and
8	native Hawaiian aquaculturalists, to streamline the permitting
9	process for and facilitate the restoration of Hawaiian
10	fishponds.
11	SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources,
12	department of health, and office of planning, in collaboration
13	with community organizations and native Hawaiian
14	aquaculturalists, shall streamline the permitting process for
15	and facilitate the restoration of Hawaiian fishponds by
16	implementing:
17	(1) One master conservation district use application
18	process that applies to all Hawaiian fishponds;
19	(2) A coastal zone management program consistency
20	statement for Hawaiian fishponds;
-	(2) Mater and its southification for Mandiday fictures

21 (3) Water quality certification for Hawaiian fishponds;



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1 (4) A general permit for Hawaiian fishponds that conforms 2 to the requirements for a Hawaiian fishpond pollution 3 discharge elimination system; and Administrative rules adopted pursuant to chapter 91, 4 (5) Hawaii Revised Statutes, to be applied consistently 5 throughout the State. 6 7 The department of land and natural resources, with input 8 from the department of health and office of planning, shall 9 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 10 any proposed legislation for a streamlined permit process for 11 the restoration of Hawaiian fishponds, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular 12 13 session of 2014.

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SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
