RELATING TO HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 89-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 3 "(e) Any action taken by the board shall be by a simple majority of the members of the board. All decisions of the 4 5 board shall be reduced to writing and shall state separately its findings of fact and conclusions. Any vacancy in the board 6 shall not impair the authority of the remaining members to 7 exercise all the powers of the board. The governor may appoint 8 9 an acting member of the board during the temporary absence from 10 the State or illness of any regular member [-,] or in the case of 11 any regular board member being unable to act for a reason such as recusal. An acting member, during the acting member's term 12 13 of service, shall have the same powers and duties as the regular 14 member[-], but subsection (d) shall not apply to an acting 15 member."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
