
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§15- Ineligibility of voter after absentee ballot
5 cast. The absentee ballot of any voter who was eligible to vote
6 at the time the ballot was cast shall not be deemed invalid
7 solely because the voter became ineligible to vote after casting
8 the ballot. For the purposes of this section, "cast" means that
9 the voter has:

- 10 (1) Deposited the absentee ballot in the mail for ballots
11 mailed in accordance with section 15-9(a)(1);
12 (2) Delivered the absentee ballot to the appropriate
13 county clerk or polling place in accordance with
14 section 15-9(a)(2) or (3); or
15 (3) Completed voting in person at an absentee polling
16 place."



1 SECTION 2. Chapter 15D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§15D- Ineligibility of covered voter after ballot
5 cast. The military-overseas ballot of any covered voter who was
6 eligible to vote at the time the ballot was cast in accordance
7 with this chapter shall not be deemed invalid solely because the
8 covered voter became ineligible to vote after casting the
9 ballot."

10 SECTION 3. Section 15-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 repealed.

12 [~~"§15-13 Death of voter prior to opening of polls.~~
13 ~~Whenever sufficient proof is shown to the clerk that an absentee~~
14 ~~voter who has returned the voter's return envelope has died~~
15 ~~prior to the opening of the polls on the date of election, the~~
16 ~~voter's ballot shall be deemed invalid and disposed of pursuant~~
17 ~~to section 11-154. The casting of any such ballot shall not~~
18 ~~invalidate the election."]~~
