## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO PREPARE A PROGRESS REPORT ON DETAILING EFFORTS TO IMPROVE AND RE-ENGINEER PROCESSING FOR ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Adult Protective Services provides crisis 1 intervention, including investigation and emergency services, to 2 vulnerable adults reported to be abused, neglected, or 3 financially exploited by others or seriously endangered due to 4 self-neglect, without regard to income; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Act 154, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, was enacted 7 to better protect vulnerable adults by expanding the Adult 8 Protective Services law contained in Chapter 346, part X, Hawaii 9 Revised Statutes; and 10 11 WHEREAS, since July 1, 2009, the Department of Human 12 Services has been accepting reports on allegations of caregiver 13 neglect, physical abuse, psychological abuse, self-neglect, 14 financial exploitation, and sexual abuse pursuant to the 15 expanded law; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the expanded law also requires the Department of 18 Human Services to investigate a report of abuse on a vulnerable 19 adult, and make an effort to refer the adult to other resources 20 so that future reports or actual abuse do not occur if the 21 Department determines that the criteria for abuse or neglect are 22 23 not met; and 24 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services has limited 25 resources and lacks additional staff and funds necessary to 26 fully implement the expansion of the adult protective services 27 law; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services indicates that it 30 is undertaking important changes to respond to the critical 31 state of Adult Protective Services, including re-engineering 32

processing according to best and evidence-based practices and 1 updating data collection; now, therefore, 2 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 5 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 6 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Human Services is requested to provide a progress report to the 7 8 Legislature detailing efforts to improve and re-engineer 9 processing for Adult Protective Services; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Human Services is requested to submit a preliminary and a final report 12 of its progress and future plans to the Legislature no later 13 than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Sessions of 14 2014 and 2015, respectively; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director 18 of Human Services, Administrator of the Social Services 19 20 Division of the Department of Human Services, and Administrator of the Adult and 21 22 Community Care Services Branch of the Social Services Division of the Department of Human Services. 23
