HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES LIBRARY COMMISSION TO EXAMINE COMMUNITIES IN THE STATE LACKING A LOCAL LIBRARY SERVICE OR RECEIVING REDUCED LIBRARY SERVICES AND TO DEVELOP AND IDENTIFY RESOURCES TO ESTABLISH A LIBRARY OR ENHANCE LIBRARY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, an informed citizenry is the foundation of 1 2 democracy; and 3 WHEREAS, research has demonstrated that early childhood 4 5 exposure to books, music, art, and science from a local library can aid in the development of children; and 6 7 WHEREAS, since statehood, the Hawaii State Public Library 8 System has been mandated to supply the people of Hawaii with 9 accessible, equitable, and appropriate library services; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Library System has been heavily 12 impacted by increased population in underserved areas and rising 13 operational expenses; and 14 15 WHEREAS, budgetary reductions and constraints over many 16 years have resulted in a twenty percent vacancy rate in staffing 17 and the permanent and temporary closure of library facilities, 18 creating inequities of service throughout the State; and 19 20 WHEREAS, adequate resources to correct this situation and 21 supply the people of Hawaii with the library and information 22 services necessary to maintain the basic standards of service to 23 which they are entitled are not available under the present 24 system of funding, as the average wait time for a new library is 25 thirty years and the average cost is \$15,000,000; and 26 27

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the underserved communities library commission is requested to examine communities in the 2 State lacking a local library service or receiving reduced 3 library services and to develop and identify resources to 4 establish a library or enhance library services provided to 5 6 those underserved communities; and 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the underserved communities 8 library commission shall consider what facilities, staffing, 9 materials, and technologies the underserved communities may need 10 and what resources can be developed to meet those needs; 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the underserved communities 13 14 library commission is requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed 15 legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior 16 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the underserved communities library commission, upon the request of the Legislature, 20 participate in a joint informational briefing to discuss its 21 22 report; and 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall cease to 24 exist on June 30, 2014; and 25 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the State 28 Librarian, the Superintendent of Education, the Director of 29 Human Services, the Chief Information Officer, the Mayor of each 30 county, the Executive Director of the Friends of the Library of 31 Hawaii, the Executive Director of the Hawaii Association of 32 Independent Schools, the Executive Director of the Hawaii Public 33 Charter Schools Network, and the President and Chief Executive 34 35 Officer of the Hawaii Community Foundation. 36 37
