HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO DEVELOP STANDARDS FOR THE TRANSPORT OF ASH GENERATED AT INCINERATION FACILITIES FOR OFFSITE RECYCLING.

WHEREAS, the Honolulu Program of Waste Energy Recovery, 1 2 commonly known as H-POWER, incinerates municipal solid waste and converts it into electricity that is sold to Hawaiian Electric 3 Company, Inc.; and 4 5 WHEREAS, H-POWER reduces the volume of waste that goes into 6 landfills by ninety per cent; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the main waste product from the operation of H-POWER or any other waste-to-energy facility is ash that is 10 currently placed in landfills; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the ash waste can be transported from the 13 incineration facility to a recycling facility, resulting in 14 15 almost no landfill use; and 16 WHEREAS, to ensure safe transport of ash waste from an 17 incineration facility to a recycling facility, the State should 18 establish a set of standards applicable to transporters of ash; 19 now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 23 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Director of 24 Health is requested to establish standards applicable to 25 transporters of ash, including fly ash and bottom ash, generated 26 at incineration facilities for offsite recycling; and 27 28
