HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO EXAMINE ALTERNATIVE WAYS TO REDESIGN THE H-1/H-2 FREEWAY MERGE TO ALLEVIATE TRAFFIC CONGESTION.

WHEREAS, Hawaii faces severe traffic problems, which 1 continue to worsen and impose substantial hardships on commuters 2 and businesses; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, excessive traffic congestion has a severe detrimental impact on Hawaii's economy, the environment, and the 6 7 guality of life for residents; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Honolulu ranked first for traffic congestion out of 100 cities in 2011 according to a study by INRIX, a provider 10 of traffic and navigation services in North America; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the INRIX study found that Honolulu drivers waste 13 an average of 58 hours per year in traffic congestion; and 14 15 WHEREAS, West Oahu commuters face some of the most severe 16 traffic congestion on Oahu as they travel toward Honolulu on 17 weekday mornings often spending several hours in traffic 18 19 gridlock; and 20 WHEREAS, a bottleneck exists at the H-1/H-2 freeway merge 21 that exacerbates the traffic congestion problem; and 22 23 WHEREAS, a comprehensive study examining the worsening 24 traffic congestion by the H-1/H-2 freeway merge would assist the 25 State in finding solutions to address one area of concern 26 regarding traffic congestion; now, therefore, 27

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 1 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 2 3 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 4 Transportation is urged to study alternative ways to alleviate 5 Eastbound traffic congestion on the H-1/H-2 freeway, 6 particularly near the H-1/H-2 merge; and 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study consider possible 8 9 ways of redesigning the H-1/H-2 freeway merge; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation submit a report, including any findings, 12 recommendations, and necessary legislation, to the Legislature 13 no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular 14 Session of 2014; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 18 19 Transportation. 20
