
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO COMPLETE A STUDY
ON POSSIBLE REVENUE GENERATING ACTIVITIES AT SAND ISLAND.

1 WHEREAS, finding new and innovative approaches to generate
2 revenue is important to the economic and financial future of our
3 state; and

5 WHEREAS, Sand Island is state-owned and the park portion of
6 Sand Island is underutilized and not well-maintained; and

7
8 WHEREAS, existing business, commercial, and water
9 activities on Sand Island would benefit from new business
10 enterprises, expanded commercial use, and development of new
11 piers and berths at Sand Island Park; and

13 WHEREAS, in order to develop new revenue from state-owned
14 land at Sand Island, new opportunities for development and
15 commercial activity should be considered; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
19 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Legislative
20 Reference Bureau is requested to study and identify new
21 opportunities for revenue generation from state-owned property
22 at Sand Island; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study shall evaluate the
25 feasibility and benefits of the revenue generating
26 opportunities, including revenue generating potential, cost, and
27 other issues that may be encountered; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference
30 Bureau is requested to submit a report of findings and

1 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
 2 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the
 3 Regular Session of 2014; and

 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 6 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
 7 Board of Land and Natural Resources and the Acting Director of
 8 the Legislative Reference Bureau.
