
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO SUBMIT
A REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE ON CURRENT AND POTENTIAL REVENUE
GENERATING ACTIVITIES ON STATE-OWNED LAND AT SAND ISLAND.

1 WHEREAS, finding new and innovative approaches to generate
2 revenue is important to the economic and financial future of our
3 state; and

4
5 WHEREAS, Sand Island is state-owned and is managed by the
6 Department of Land and Natural Resources; and

7
8 WHEREAS, the state-managed park portion of Sand Island is
9 underutilized and shows signs of decay; and

10
11 WHEREAS, existing industrial, business, commercial, and
12 marine-related activities on Sand Island would benefit from new
13 business enterprises, expanded commercial use, and development
14 of new piers and berths at Sand Island Park; now, therefore

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
17 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
18 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
19 Land and Natural Resources is requested to submit a report to
20 the Legislature on current and potential revenue generating
21 activities on state-owned land at Sand Island; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
24 Natural Resources is requested to evaluate the potential
25 challenges and benefits of revenue generation on state-owned
26 land at Sand Island including potential costs, revenue
27 projections, and other issues that may arise; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
30 Natural Resources is requested to submit a report of findings
31 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the



1 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the
2 Regular Session of 2014; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
5 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
6 Board of Land and Natural Resources.
