

## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH TO ADOPT RULES TO AUTHORIZE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEWS OF CERTAIN ACTIONS COMMITTED BY AGENTS OR INSPECTORS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.
