7	2000, any state may request the Joint Committee on the Library
- 8	of Congress to approve the replacement of a statue a state has
9	provided for display in National Statuary Hall under two
10	conditions:

12	(1) The request has been approved by a resolution adopted
13	by the Legislature of the state and the request has
14	been approved by the Governor of the state; and

16	(2) The statue to be replaced has been displayed in the
17	Capitol of the United States for at least 10 years as
18	of the time the request is made; however, the Joint
19	Committee on the Library of Congress may waive this
20	requirement for cause at the request of a state; and

23	also worthy of honor and recognition in National Statuary Hall "for their historic renown or for distinguished civic or
