## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII TO PRESERVE THE COUNTIES' SHARE OF THE TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

WHEREAS, the transient accommodations tax is a tax levied 1 by the State on the proceeds derived from furnishing transient 2 accommodations; and 3 4 WHEREAS, during the Regular Session of 1990, the 5 Legislature enacted Act 185 which gave the counties a share of 6 the transient accommodations tax; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, according to Conference Committee Report 207, the purpose of Act 185 was to provide a more equitable method of 10 sharing state revenues with the counties, rather than continuing 11 with the system existing at the time, whereby the counties 12 requested financial assistance through grants-in-aid from the 13 State; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the county share of the tax also provides more 16 stability to county finances and enables improved budgeting and 17 planning; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, currently, 44.8 per cent of the total transient accommodations tax collected by the State is distributed to the 21 counties; of this amount, the revenue is allocated as follows: 22 23 Kauai County 14.5% 24 Hawaii County 18.6% 25 City and County of Honolulu 44.18 26 \_ Maui County 27 \_ 22.8% 28 100.08 29 30 and 31

1 WHEREAS, the transient accommodations tax revenues account for a significant portion of the counties' general fund budgets; 2 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, maintaining the current allocation of the transient accommodations tax would allow the counties to 6 continue providing essential government services to visitors and 7 residents; and 8 9 WHEREAS, losing the current allocation of the transient 10 accommodations tax would require counties to significantly raise 11 property taxes; now, therefore, 12 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 15 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Governor and 16 the Legislature are urged to preserve the counties' share of the 17 transient accommodations tax; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 20 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the President of the 21 Hawaii State Association of Counties, and the Mayors of the 22 Counties of Kauai, Hawaii, Honolulu, and Maui. 23 24 25 26 Month OFFERED BY:
