
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO RESTRIPE
SOUTHBOUND LANES OF FORT WEAVER ROAD FROM TWO LANES TO
THREE LANES BEGINNING AT THE FORT WEAVER ROAD AND H-1
OVERPASS.

1 WHEREAS, the southbound lanes of Fort Weaver Road are prone
2 to severe congestion during rush hour traffic; and
3

4 WHEREAS, restriping the southbound lanes of Fort Weaver
5 Road from two lanes to three lanes would greatly improve
6 vehicular traffic flow; and

8 WHEREAS, the northbound lanes of Fort Weaver Road are
9 already striped for three lanes; and

11 WHEREAS, traffic flows much more smoothly on the northbound
12 lanes; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
15 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
16 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
17 Transportation is requested to restripe the southbound lanes of
18 Fort Weaver Road from two lanes to three lanes beginning at the
19 Ford Weaver Road and H-1 overpass; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
23 Transportation.
