14 15 16 17 18 19	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Transportation is requested to restripe the southbound lanes of Fort Weaver Road from two lanes to three lanes beginning at the Ford Weaver Road and H-1 overpass; and
