HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO USE THE H-1 FREEWAY ZIPPER LANE DURING THE AFTERNOON RUSH HOUR FOR WESTBOUND TRAFFIC.

WHEREAS, Oahu's growing population has increased vehicular 1 traffic dramatically, especially on Oahu's west side; and 2 3 WHEREAS, attempts by the Department of Transportation to 4 expedite the flow of traffic on the H-1 freeway and other 5 thoroughfares have been met with various levels of success; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Department has established zipper lanes which 8 converts the use of a highway lane to the opposite direction of 9 travel depending on traffic needs; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the use of zipper lanes is restricted by the 12 number of passengers in the vehicle and the time of day; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the zipper lane, while effective, is only used on 15 the H-1 freeway for eastbound traffic during the morning rush 16 hour; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the full potential of the zipper lane on the H-1 19 freeway is yet to be realized; now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 23 Session of 2013, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 24 Transportation is urged to use the H-1 freeway zipper lane 25 during afternoon rush hour for westbound traffic; and 26 27
