BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no member of the Task Force shall be made subject to Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of that member's participation as a member of the Task Force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference Bureau is requested to assist the task force in preparing its findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation; provided that the Chairperson of the task force is requested to submit a draft of the task force's recommendations to the Legislative Reference Bureau for drafting no later than November 1, 2013; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; Director of Transportation; Mayor of each county; Chair of the County Council for each county including the City Council of the City and County of Honolulu; Chairperson of the Senate Standing Committee on Water and Land; Chairperson of the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Water & Land; and Acting Director of the Legislative Reference Bureau.
