## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO COMPLETE A STUDY ON POSSIBLE REVENUE GENERATING ACTIVITIES AT SAND ISLAND.

WHEREAS, finding new and innovative approaches to generate 1 revenue is important to the economic and financial future of our 2 3 state; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Sand Island is state-owned and the park portion of Sand Island is underutilized and not well-maintained; and 6 7 WHEREAS, existing business, commercial, and water 8 activities on Sand Island would benefit from new business 9 enterprises, expanded commercial use, and development of new 10 piers and berths at Sand Island Park; and 11 12 WHEREAS, in order to develop new revenue from state-owned 13 14 land at Sand Island, new opportunities for development and 15 commercial activity should be considered; now, therefore, 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 17 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 18 Session of 2013, that the Legislative Reference Bureau is 19 requested to study and identify new opportunities for revenue 20 generation from state-owned property at Sand Island; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study shall evaluate the 23 feasibility and benefits of the revenue generating 24 opportunities, including revenue generating potential, cost, and 25 other issues that may be encountered; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference 28 Bureau is requested to submit a report of findings and 29 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 30 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 31 Regular Session of 2014; and 32




