HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENTS OF DEFENSE AND HOMELAND SECURITY TO ASSESS HAWAII'S VULNERABILITY TO NUCLEAR ATTACK AND THE ABILITY OF THE UNITED STATES TO DEFEND HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii is a central location for strategic purposes with regards to the Pacific region; and 2 3 WHEREAS, foreign entities have declared their intent to 4 launch a nuclear attack on the United States of America; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Hawaii geographically is significantly closer to 7 these foreign entities than the continental United States and, 8 therefore, is more vulnerable to attacks by them; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the protection of Hawaii's residents is of utmost 11 importance to the State; now, therefore, 12 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 15 Session of 2013, that the United States Department of Defense 16 and the United States Department of Homeland Security are 17 requested to work together to assess Hawaii's vulnerability to 18 nuclear attack by foreign nations and other entities and the 19 ability of the United States to defend Hawaii from nuclear 20 attack; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Department of 23 Defense and the United States Department of Homeland Security 24 are requested to submit a report of their assessment to the 25 Governor and the Legislature, including any recommended actions 26 to improve the State's ability to prepare for and respond to 27 such an attack; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Resolution be transmitted to the United States Secretary of 31 Defense, the United States Secretary of Homeland Security, the 32
