CONGRATULATING JULIA SEGAWA AND CHARLES SOUZA JR. AS RECIPIENTS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE TEACHING; PATRICK McNALLY AS THE RECIPIENT OF THE 2012 LIBRARIAN OF THE YEAR AWARD; AND BERRY ANDELIN AS THE RECIPIENT OF THE 2012 EXCELLENCE IN SERVICE AWARD.

1 WHEREAS, the people of Hawaii take great pride in
2 recognizing and honoring the notable achievements and
3 contributions of educators who, through their extraordinary
4 dedication and personal efforts, significantly improve the

7 WHEREAS, JULIA SEGAWA, a recipient of the Presidential
8 Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching, is a
9 science teacher at R. L. Stevenson Middle School and has been an
10 educator for 16 years; she founded the school's Robotics Team,
11 coordinated annual Science Nights, excursions, and science
12 fairs, was instrumental in securing the school's Science
13 Signature School status, and was also part of a team that
14 designed and constructed a new science and technology building;

17 WHEREAS, CHARLES SOUZA JR., a state resource teacher is a
18 recipient of the Presidential Award for Excellence in
19 Mathematics and Science Teaching and taught mathematics at R. L.
20 Stevenson Middle School for 15 years; he served as the school's
21 mathematics department chairperson for 5 years and coached the
22 school's Mathematics Team for 15 years; he also served as the
23 middle school coordinator, where he created an advisory
24 curriculum that focused on developing life skills for students
25 as well as supporting other academic curriculums; and

27 WHEREAS, PATRICK McNALLY, a librarian at the Hawaii State
28 Library, is the recipient of Hawaii's 2012 Librarian of the Year
29 Award; he has worked at the Hawaii State Library since 1992,



1 overseeing vital capital improvements, coordinating community
2 events, and in addition, maintaining a high level of service for
3 the general public; and

5 WHEREAS, BERRY ANDELIN, the Circulation Department Support
6 Staff Supervisor at the Manoa Public Library, is the recipient
7 of Hawaii's 2012 Excellence in Service Award, having dedicated
8 many hours of work to the library system; now, therefore,
