HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REVIEW POLICY NO. 6701 IN LIGHT OF THE STATE'S EFFORT TO RENOVATE AND BUILD TWENTY-FIRST CENTURY SCHOOLS AND TO REPORT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE LEGISLATURE.

WHEREAS, children in Hawaii deserve to be educated in 1 environments and facilities that are conducive to learning and 2 meet twenty-first century standards; and 3 4 WHEREAS, school districts throughout the State suffer from 5 aging schools, maintenance backlogs, and budget shortfalls; and 6 7 WHEREAS, on average, schools in Hawaii are sixty-five years 8 old and more than forty schools exceed one hundred years in age; 9 10 and 11 WHEREAS, student achievement is limited by the current 12 condition of school facilities; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the State is exploring a project to renovate and 15 build new schools to meet twenty-first century standards to 16 address its aging school facilities; and 17 18 WHEREAS, twenty-first century schools would incorporate new 19 strategies for school design to accommodate a wide range of 20 learning styles, promote community interaction with the school, 21 and allow the use of advanced technology and energy efficient 22 systems; and 23 24 WHEREAS, section 302A-1602, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and 25 Board of Education policy no. 6701, relating to acreage 26 guidelines for elementary, middle, and high schools may limit 27 the State's plan to renovate and build new schools that meet 28 twenty-first century standards; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 31 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 32 Session of 2013, that the Board of Education is requested to 33

review policy no. 6701 and section 302A-1602, Hawaii Revised 1 Statutes, in light of the State's effort to renovate and build 2 twenty-first century schools; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education is 5 requested to report to the Legislature no later than twenty days 6 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2014 its 7 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, regarding 8 whether the acreage guidelines of section 302A-1602, Hawaii 9 Revised Statutes, and policy no. 6701 should be changed to 10 accommodate the twenty-first century schools concept; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 13 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Chairperson of the 14 Board of Education. 15 16 17 OFFERED BY: Findele 18
