

1 nonsectarian private educational institution, except that public
2 funds may be appropriated for the support or benefit of private
3 early childhood education programs, as provided by law, and that
4 proceeds of special purpose revenue bonds authorized or issued
5 under section 12 of Article VII may be appropriated to finance
6 or assist:

7 1. Not-for-profit corporations that provide early
8 childhood education and care facilities serving the general
9 public; and

10 2. Not-for-profit private nonsectarian and sectarian
11 elementary schools, secondary schools, colleges and
12 universities."

13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
14 be as follows:

15 "Shall the appropriation of public funds be permitted for
16 the support or benefit of private early childhood education
17 programs, as provided by law?"

18 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

19 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect on July 1,
20 2050, upon compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the
21 Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
